## **Instructions, Limitations, and Terms**

1. Only residents within the Big Sky Resort Tax Area District are eligible for showerhead rebates.
2. Showerheads are limited to four (4) per installation address.
3. Tenants should submit an owner authorized letter.
4. Old showerheads cannot be reused
5. Applicants must bring their old showerhead or agree to destroy or disable their old showerhead.
6. Installation of showerheads is the sole responsibility of the applicant.
7. The showerheads must be installed at the installation address listed.
8. Showerheads will be issued on a first-come, first-serve basis based on availability.

## **Important! Please read carefully**

1. Gallatin River Task Force staff and agents reserve the right to do an on-site inspection to verify installed showerhead(s) rebated through this program. Access to the rebated showerhead(s) must be provided at the time of inspection. If showerhead installation(s) cannot be verified, the payee will reimburse Gallatin River Task Force for the rebate funds received.
2. Gallatin River Task Force staff and agents may contact applicant by phone or in writing to verify information provided for in the application and/or to schedule an inspection. Any inspection shall occur during regular business hours.
